LBNC Bylaws Article V GOVERNING BOARD:

Section 1: Composition

C: ORGANIZATIONAL Stakeholder Representative: An OSR shall be any person who participates in a religious institution, educational institution, community organization, non-profit organization, neighborhood association, school/parent group, faith based group, senior group, youth group, arts association, service organization, boys or girls club, cultural group, or environmental group within the Council's boundaries.

Section 6: Vacancies

- **C:** The board shall vote on the application at the meeting. If multiple applications for one (1) seat have been submitted the candidate with the most votes wins. In the event of a tie, a coin toss between the candidates with the most votes shall determine the seat appointment.
