BYLAWS - Section 6: Vacancies – Vacancies on the Board shall be filled using the following procedure:

- A. Any "Stakeholder" interested in filling a vacancy on the Board shall submit a written application to the Board, providing that Community Stakeholder is qualified for that particular seat. The Board shall cause the matter to be placed on the agenda for the next regular meeting of the Board.
- B. The Board shall vote on the application at the meeting. If multiple applications for one (1) seat have been submitted, the candidate with the most votes wins. In the event of a tie, a coin toss between the candidates with the most votes shall determine the seat appointment

Organizational Stakeholder Representatives (OSR) – Open to Stakeholders eighteen (18) years of age or older who participate in a community based organization, including but not limited to a religious institution, educational institution, non-profit organization, neighborhood association, school/parent group, faith based group, senior group, youth group, arts association, service organization, boys or girls club, cultural group, or environmental group within the NC boundaries

At-Large Appointed Stakeholder Representatives (ALASR) – The ALASRs must meet the criteria for an RSBM, BSBM, or OSBM. In making the appointments, the Board will appoint "Stakeholder" who are not currently represented or are underrepresented on the Board, in order to achieve and foster full representation
