**Keep Trash Bins Out-of-Sight:
Let's Keep Lake Balboa Beautiful**

Taking out trash bins way in advance of trash pickup day and leaving them on the curb (or worse yet, on your lawn) probably irritates your neighbors and makes our community less beautiful. The L.A. Bureau of Sanitation handles household refuse, trash containers and collection regulations. The regulations state that containers must be placed at the curb by 6:00 AM. on the day of collection, and removed no later than 8:00 PM on the day of collection. As a reminder, holiday trash collection is postponed by one day for July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Years Day. Please do not put trash bins on the curb on any of these holidays, as it will not be picked up until a day later. If you have any questions, call 1-800-773-2488 or 311.
