Our LAPD Senior Lead Officers

Our first line of contact for police matters (other than 911 emergencies) is our Senior Lead Officers (SLOs). Saul Paredes has the area from the I-405 to Balboa Blvd. from Roscoe to Sherman Way and from the I-405 to Hayvenhurst from Sherman Way to Victory. This includes Van Nuys Airport. Dave Ham covers the rest of our Lake Balboa Neighborhood Council Area including the Sepulveda Dam Basin. Now that the Topanga Area Police Station has opened the LAPD redrew the boundaries for service. We now have our area served from the West Valley Division at 19020 Vanowen St. (just west of Wilbur Avenue).
