## Exactly Where is the Community of Lake Balboa?

On November 2, 2007 the City of Los Angeles officially designated Lake Balboa as one of the many communities in L.A. It now includes all of zip code 91406 west of the I-405 freeway except the area around (and including) Van Nuys Airport and the mostly industrial section east of the airport and north of Saticoy St. Also a part of Lake Balboa is the area south of Victory Blvd. to the Los Angles River that is east of Balboa Blvd., so it includes Beilenson Park (where the Lake Balboa is), Woodley Park, the Japanese Gardens, the Wildlife area east of Woodley Ave., and the Woodley Lakes Golf Course.



To celebrate this official renaming, the Lake Balboa Neighborhood Council is sponsoring Lake Balboa Day on April 25th, from 11AM to 3PM at Beilenson Park.

Both of our City Councilpersons, Tony Cardenas (CD 6) and Greig Smith (CD 12) will be attending the event. Join us for fun, free food, facts and friendship.
