Therefore you may run for a seat on the Board! You can be a leader in the community. Be part of a historic moment and contribute to the betterment of your community. Help make sure the voice of your community is heard!

As an elected Board member you will represent your neighborhood's voice in the City of Los Angeles on such issues as land use and planning, emergency preparedness, beautification, and many other matters of concern to our community. You will have a voice in how to best spend the annual budget. If you would like to make a difference in Lake Balboa on these issues and are available to take an active role at our meetings, please consider running for one of the 15 seats up for election on our Board. Or you could sit back and do nothing if you don't care about the quality of life issues facing our neighborhood council area.

The candidate filing period is February 26—March 30. This time we are sharing our election day with 10 other neighborhood councils throughout the south valley and we are known as "Region C". The Los Angeles City Clerk will administer our elections. This means that all details related to candidate filing and qualifications, voter qualifications and election day ballots is supervised and certified by the L.A. City Clerk. The LBNC looks forward to an active elections process with candidates running for office and neighbors coming out to vote on election day.
