People are flocking to this great Lake Balboa destination. There's no better place, anywhere in the Valley and beyond, to fly model airplanes and helicopters. And, the people are friendly. Here's an excerpt from the website -valleyflyers.com.

The Valley Flyers are a group of model aviation enthusiasts from all over Southern California who enjoy building and flying radio control model aircraft. The main emphasis' of the club are the promotion of model aviation, to maintain the Apollo XI field both physically and politically for model aviation, and to promote good fellowship and community relations.

The Apollo XI field is located at 6201 Woodley Avenue, directly across from Woodley Park between Victory Blvd. and Burbank Blvd. in the Sepulveda Basin. The flying field is available every day from dawn to dusk except during sanctioned field events.

Red Cross Emergency Response/LAFD CERT III Class Comes to Lake Balboa

The 80 hour American Red Cross Emergency Response Course/Los Angeles Fire Department Community Emergency Response Training-Level III Class will be taught for the first time in Lake Balboa beginning April 24th for four Saturdays every other week from 9-5 and for six consecutive Tuesdays and Thursdays from 6-10 by a cadre of Los Angeles Emergency Preparedness experts at 7412 Balboa Blvd., home of our Neighborhood Council meetings. At least one member of every family, and emergency team at work and school should complete this class.

Classes will include CPR for the Professional Rescuer, Automated External Defibrillator usage, Oxygen Administration, and Advanced Skills such as treatment of stroke, seizure, heart attack, burns, wounds, head, neck and back injuries, bites, poisoning, heat and cold related emergencies. Triage, bandaging, splinting, back-boarding, radio skills, emergency childbirth and water safety will also be taught.

You will receive textbooks, CPR mask, and a basic First Responder Kit of equipment. Red Cross Certifications in Oxygen Administration, CPR for the Professional Rescuer, Emergency Response, Help Delayed Response, AED, Backboarding, Disease Transmission Prevention, and Community Water Safety will be awarded upon successful completion of skills demonstration and written exam. A Title 22 certification option is available. Class is physically demanding and requires time spent on floor for some skills development. The cost, \$455.00, includes textbooks and all equipment. Class Size is limited to 20 and is expected to fill quickly.
