## New Lawn Watering Schedule in Effect

The new lawn watering schedule allows residents to water their lawns before 9:00 a.m. and after 4:00 p.m. as follows:

**Odd-numbered addresses:** Water on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays, 8 minutes per day.

**Even-numbered addresses:** Water on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays, 8 minutes per day.

**Addresses ending in a fraction:** Follow the schedule for the last whole number on the address.

Or you can just hand water, which is allowed without time limits, before 9 a.m. and after 4:00 p.m., any day of the week so long as you use a garden hose and flow control nozzle.

## Tired of Unsightly Mobile Billboards in Our Community?

Take action by letting our Governor know that you support AB 2756, proposed by Assemblymember Bob Blumenfield, which helps ban mobile billboards. AB 2756 has already passed the state Assembly, and is moving through the state Senate this month. If passed, it becomes law only if signed by the Governor.
