Participants will receive a Pet First Aid Book and Certificate of Completion, but YOU MUST PRE-REGISTER. Just \$20 (regularly \$45), and you'll learn how to save the lives and treat the injuries of your beloved dogs and cats.

And, on **February 19th and 20th**, the Lake Balboa Neighborhood Council will host a rare weekend CERT I Class! FREE! Get all 17 hours of training and your Certificate of Completion in just two days at 7412 Balboa Blvd., just north of Sherman Way in Lake Balboa. Classes will be taught by CERT Commander Stacy Gerlich from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. each day. Learn fire suppression, search and rescue, triaging, quick first air, latest info on terrorism, and much, much more. The Council will furnish a continental breakfast, light lunch and snacks.
