JULY 15 7pm,16,17,18 till 6am the 405 freeway will be closed from the 101 to 10 fwys. Instead of dealing with the insane traffic come join us for our Clean Up day on Sunday July 17, 2011. So plan ahead!

In an effort to reduce congestion, improve mobility and increase safety, Caltrans is working on the 405 Freeway in the Sepulveda Pass. They are adding a high-occupancy vehicle lane, standardizing lane sizes, and improving on-and off ramps along a 10-mile-long stretch of the freeway between the 10 Freeway (Santa Monica) and the 101 Freeway (Ventura). Work on this project is causing frequent closures of off-and on ramps and various other work that could disrupt the commute for Valley residents.

But you must apply before you take action to cutting the tree down. You can obtain a free permit by calling 311 for information.

Did you know that the L. A. City Bureau of Sanitation will repair/replace your damaged refuse containers at no charge? A call to 800-773-CITY will schedule replacement or repair of your Black, Green, or Blue container, usually for the day after your next collection day. Have the serial number on the container available when you make the call.
