NEIGHBORHOOD COMMUNITY WATCH! Things that a burglar will not tell you: If decorative glass is part of your front entrance, don't let your alarm company install the control pad where I can see if it's set. that makes it too easy. A good security company alarms the window over the sink. And the windows on the second floor, which often access the master bedroom - and your jewelry. It's not a bad idea to put motion detectors up there too. It's raining, you're fumbling with your umbrella, and you forget to lock your door - understandable. But understand this: I don't take a day off because of bad weather. I always knock first. If you answer, I'll ask for directions somewhere or offer to clean your gutters. (Don't take me up on it.)

Remember folks even though we live in the city we still have lots of wildlife around us. Please be aware of Coyotes and other wild life.

Call 800–996-2489 and/or to report illegal signs, please have locations such as the intersection or street address handy.

Did you know that you can replace your damaged trash cans? LA City Bureau of Sanitation will repair/ replace refuse containers at NO CHARGE! Call 1-800–773–CITY to schedule a replacement or repair of your Black, Green or Blue containers. Have your serial number on the container available when you make your call.
