Free parking in the short term lot in front, in the spaces nearest Woodley Ave.

Some 30 million people live within a 50 mile radius of San Onofre Nuclear Power Plant. And, a terrorist's 'dirty bomb' is an ongoing threat to those living in the Los Angeles area. Do YOU know how to protect your family in the event of a nuclear event? David Bloombaum trained with the US Navy Nuclear Submarine Service for seven years, and from 1975 through 1979 worked as Senior Health Physics Technician at nine commercial nuclear facilities throughout the US. In 1979 he was one of three radiation specialists called by Metropolitan Edison to Three Mile Island to enter the plant and measure levels of contamination from the melt-down there. Co-host of Radio Programs in the Los Angeles area in 1984 and 85 and the author of several publications, David will be our guest speaker at this Emergency Preparedness Meeting that you cannot afford to miss!
