





Lake Balboa Neighborhood Council has invited all candidates for the City Council CD6 to a candidates forum during our regular meeting on **Wednesday, May 1st**. The Candidate Forum will be held at the beginning of the meeting. Each candidate will have an opportunity to tell us why they deserve our votes and how they will represent us if they are elected. The primary election for this seat takes place on May 21st. If a candidate receives more than 50% of the vote in the May 21st election, they win the seat outright. Otherwise the two candidates with the most votes in the primary will advance to the runoff election scheduled for July 23rd.

We value this opportunity to connect our residents and businesses with the candidates seeking to represent us at City Hall.

Please join us in taking an active role in selecting our representation. Your vote matters!

# Land Use and Planning Issue on the Agenda in May

At our May 1 meeting we will have a presentation from Tesla Motors about their proposed electric car sales,

service and repair facility in our Lake Balboa Neighborhood Council area. The location would be **6919-21 Hayvenhurst Ave**. The LBNC would like stakeholders' input before deciding to support or oppose the project. A conditional use permit is required as the M1-1 zoning prohibits automobile repair facilities within 500 feet of residential property and it back up to those on De Celis Pl.
