Land Use Committee



Do you know what the boundaries of Lake Balboa Are? As the map shows it is a lot of territory but it is not all ours. From Victory south (the park) is shared with Encino NC. However, north of the park is about 3.34 square miles with about 43,500 people living in that area. We also have the Van Nuys Airport in the center of the community and the Budweiser Brew-

ery to the north east. It is the largest beer company in America. We also have La Brea Bakery, one of the largest bakeries in the US with Costco being one of its largest customers.

Come to our meetings to learn what is happening in our community. We need to hear from you to represent you in all Land Use decisions.

Sherman Way Tunnel—New lights are being installed, broken and missing tiles will be replaced, a new security system is being installed. This is a joint effort of CD6-Nury Martinez, Van Nuys Airport, Airtel Hotel, Security Lines US and LBNC. West Valley LAPD will monitor the security cameras.

LBNC—Database we are receiving the LA County voter records for Lake Balboa to reach a larger segment of our community. In the future you will be asked to opt in should you wish to be updated on what is happening in our neighborhoods. We ask that you DO opt in so that we can let you know of any Land Use issues, Safety Classes, updates on CERT (Community Emergency Response Team) classes and future surveys.
