 - -Less than 1/3 of sudden cardiac arrest victims are administered immediate CPR from bystanders.
 - -The use of CPR dates all the way back to 1740, yet even today, most Americans don't know how to perform it.
 - -About 92% of sudden cardiac arrest victims die before reaching the hospital, but stats prove that if more people know CPR, more lives could be saved. Double or triple a victims chance of survival.
